- Understand the role of other international organizations in global governance.

- The Security Council: Powers and procedures, peacekeeping operations, sanctions, and the use of force.
- International Peace and Security: Addressing conflict, terrorism, and disarmament.
- The Role of Regional Organizations: In maintaining international peace and security.

## Day 3: Economic and Social Development

- The Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC): Role and functions in promoting economic and social development.
- Key UN Agencies:
  - UNDP, UNICEF, WHO, FAO, UNESCO, and other specialized agencies.
  - Their mandates, activities, and impact.
- The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):
  - Understanding and implementing the SDGs.

  - o Key principles and provisions.
- Human Rights Treaties and Mechanisms:

- The Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR):
  - o Role and functions in promoting and protecting human rights

## Day 5: Challenges and Reforms

- Challenges facing the UN system:
  - o Reform of the Security Council, financing issues, and accountability.
  - o Relevance and effectiveness of the UN in the 21st century.
- The Future of the UN System:
  - o Adapting to new challenges and emerging issues.
  - o Strengthening cooperation and partnerships.
  - o The role of technology and innovation.

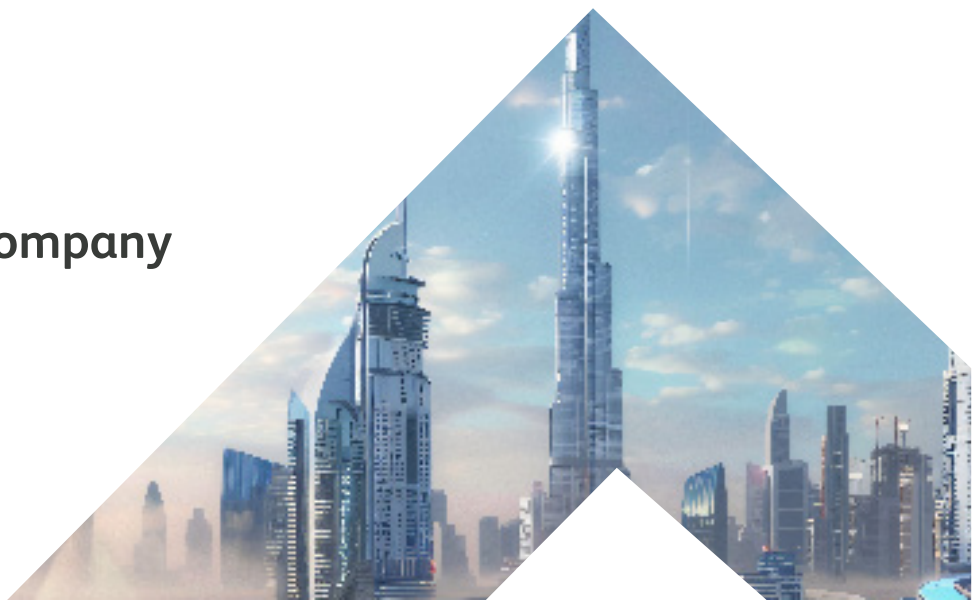
